September

Mon., Sept. 8:

Deadline for Senior Questionnaire completion and update of resume (remember to include hrs/wk and wks/yr) and college list on senior's Family Connection website. Please delete any colleges you are no longer considering

Meeting for all seniors considering ED/EA/Early Rolling applications, 1:15 pm, Lecture Hall. Students whose first choice college has any version of an "early notification" plan should also attend if they are considering applying under such a program

Tues., Sept. 9

SAT registration deadline for October 4th test

Wed., Sept. 10:

College Program for Senior Parents (no students), 7:00 p.m., Christensen Hall.

Fri., Sept. 12:

Last date to **make appointment** for senior meeting with your college counselor. Early applicants should complete their senior meetings by this date. All senior appointments should take place by Oct. 3rd

Fri., Sept. 26:

Deadline to submit all SSR forms for early action/decision/rolling. Update your Family Connection college application list

SAT registration deadline for November 1st exam date

October

All month: Cal State Application filing period begins. CSS Profile Web Registration Guide available in college counseling office. Students applying for financial aid at private colleges should register for the CSS Profile at this time

SAT at Chadwick (7:40 a.m. arrival)

Weds., Oct. 8:

U.C. Application Workshop, G period, Lecture Hall

Thurs., Oct. 16:

Financial Aid Workshop, Part I, 7:00 p.m., Lecture Hall

November

All month: UC and Cal State Application filing period. Students are strongly recommended to mail their final application no later than **November 15th**

Nov. 1 - 15:

Early Action, Early Decision and Early Notification (rolling admission colleges) application deadlines

Sat., Nov.1:

SAT (away)

Mon, Nov. 3:

Last date to give UC/CSU application draft to your college counselor if you want him or her to review it. After this date, applications will be reviewed depending upon counselor availability

Final deadline to update Family Connection college application list, submit *signed* Final College List and all SSR forms to the college counseling office as well as recommendation forms to your teachers

Weds., Nov. 5:

SAT Registration Deadline for Dec. 6th

Fri.,Nov. 28

Final date to have your college counselor review your application essays. After this date, essays and applications will be reviewed depending upon counselor availability. Your college counselor will *not* be available to review your essays over the Winter Break

Nov. 30: Absolute final deadline for the UC applications and CSU applications

December

All month: Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) forms available online and in the college counseling office. GPA verification forms for Cal Grant available

Sat., Dec. 6: SAT off-campus. Scores from this test date are usually the last that colleges will accept

Sat., Dec.13: Financial Aid Workshop, Part II, 9:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m., Lecture Hall

Mon., Dec. 15: Early action/decision candidates notified around this time

December 15-30: Mail the rest of your applications by this time (be sure to keep a copy of all of your applications and either get a certificate of mailing from the post office or print the receipt for applications filed online)

ALL SAT TEST SCORES AND SAT SUBJECT TEST SCORES SHOULD BE SENT TO COLLEGES BY NOW

January

All month: Turn in GPA verification forms if applying for FAFSA and Cal Grant to your counselor

Jan. 1 - Feb. 15: Deadlines for majority of college applications

Jan. 1: Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) filing period begins

February

All month: Turn in GPA verification forms if applying for FAFSA and Cal Grant to your counselor

Feb. 9 - 13: Mid- year school reports with 7th semester grades mailed to colleges this week

March

Thurs., March 1: Financial Aid filing deadline (some colleges have earlier deadlines—be sure to check with each individual college.) GPA Verification Forms for Cal Grant and FAFSA due

March 1-30: U.C.'s notify all applicants during this time

Weds., March 11: College Transition Program for Seniors and Parents, 7:00 p.m. Christensen Hall

April

April 1 - 15: Final admission decision notification received from colleges. Students can plan to visit colleges during this time by making arrangements with Mrs. Hall or Mr. Wiedenmann

Wed., April 22: Pre-administration for AP Exams during G period, Lecture Hall

May

Sat., May 1: National Candidate's Reply Date (enrollment deposits due at the college where the student will matriculate)

May 4-15: AP Exams. (Make-up exams: May 19-21)

May - June: Wait list notification

June

Fri., June 19: Final Chadwick transcript mailed to college where student is matriculating
